### Monday 19th Covid Update

Hope you are well; we welcome some sun this week which we hope will all get you out on the courses.

I would like to take this opportunity to update you with our covid restrictions starting on Monday 19th July.

From Monday, rakes will be back out in the bunkers. We have ordered some new rakes so we are aiming to get at least 2 in each bunker. Please rake your divot and footprints before you walk off, making sure the sand is left smooth. Rake it as you would expect to find it.

You will now be able to remove flags out of the hole if you wish. Attachments will stay on the flag for those who wish to not remove it.

Face masks will not be required by customers or staff however if you wish to wear it that is fine.

No social distancing requirements.

Extra hand sanitiser units will be installed out on the golf course.

Ball washers will be installed back on the course for when the winter months arrive.

Changing rooms and showers will now be open.

We still advise if you have any symptoms that you stay at home and do not visit the club.

The following message has come from Springs and is in relation to the functions rooms and cafe.

- \* Face coverings for staff and customers will not be required
- \* No Social distancing requirements
- \* We will not be checking on a persons vaccine or Test status before entry
- \* Table service will no longer be offered
- \* Customers will need to queue via a one way system (side door) to the till point. We will serve customers everything at the end of the bar (apart from food that will be taken to the table once prepared)
- \* There is no requirement for tables of 6
- \* We will place our own limits on numbers within Howellers and Fairways that make them safe events for all
- \* We will ensure adequate air flow at all times
- \* We will provide sanitiser to customers
